1. <http://teachingmaterials.no-ip.org/> This is a link to an excellent series of course books, CD's, Instant Ideas and extra material. Many of the textbooks have a link to a CD (a trial version which takes one minute to load) with multi-learning media. Teachers can consult this resource, prepare classes and send emails with the selected chapters as an attached PDF file for printing to their students or Copy Ready. To access this resource, in the user name and password panel, use the first letter of your first name, followed by your last name: Jason Sears would be **jsears** and the initial default password is **materials**. For continuing teachers, before Dec 31st, 2009, who already have a user name and password in **My Hours**, it will be the same user name and password.

It can also be used to encourage students to write creatively on their own.
